In November of 2010, Molin Concrete Products was contacted by Jeff Walker of Opus Northwest regarding the Stadium Village Flats Project. Original design development plans showed the Stadium Village Flats designed with three levels of post tensioned deck. With an aggressive schedule, tight jobsite and a budget to consider, Opus met with the Molin design build team to begin converting this project to precast. The Molin Engineering and Drafting team started the shop drawing and engineering process at the same time Opus was finalizing the structural plans. Molin was able to save time and incorporate value engineering into the final structural documents. The result was a seamless transition with three levels of precast providing sound dampening and fire separation between the parking, retail and housing units above.
