Molin also provided precast products for the Headquarters Building, the TCO Medical Office Building, the TCO Practice Stadium, the TCO Sports Medicine Building, STEM Tech Office Building and the STEM Parking Garage. This project required installation of the precast wall panels after several areas of projecting structural steel had been installed. Molin worked with the project team to coordinate this unique construction sequence, successfully completing the installation of the "tucked under" precast panels. The architectural precast wall panels incorporated various angular configurations using a combination of two unique form-liner patterns with etched finishes cast using an architectural mix design that included local sand and aggregates sourced from Granite Falls.
